Visé - 4600

Visé, a sweet little Mosane town in the province of Liège, is half way between La Cité Ardente (The Fiery City, Liège's nickname) and Maastricht.

Ittre - 1460

Basin upstream for the Ittre lock (number 5f) on the Charleroi Bruxelles canal. Peaceful and green area.

The Thieu Leisure Marina can be found on the historical Canal du centre (350 tons), between the boat lift number 4 and the lock number 1, towards Havré.

The marina, 1.5 km from Amée beach, can welcome 72 boats, including a few spaces for those up to 28 metres in length.
