Liège's Christmas village features 200 lodges, presenting all kinds of seasonal products and this over 5 weeks: the perfect place to find the perfect gift.

The Christmas market's activities

Think of it as a village, with 4 iconic houses: the Chalet de la Gruyère, La Maison ardennaise, La Maison du Pèket and the Chalet "Au pied des pistes".

There is much to see, do and try: a sledge run, an ice rink, a puppet nativity scene, and even a collection of Christmas decorations, made of blown glass then hand painted, each presenting a Walloon folkloric figure (Tchantchès, Nanesse, Marcachou, a miner, Gilles de Binche, the cotiresse, even the famous Place Saint Lambert's little plane).

New this year: the Christmas shuttle, the touristic train and the guest of honour, straight from the Savoie: a lodge dedicated to Châtel.
